

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

January 23, 2013

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, January 23, 2013 at the Township Office, 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Conrad Kasperson, Diane Tyson, Jim Everhart, John Lamparter, and Chris Chretien. Also present was Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager and Charlie Thomas, Public Works Director. The meeting was called to order by Conrad Kasperson at 7:00 pm.

A motion was made by Jim Everhart and seconded by John Lamparter to approve the October 24, 2012 minutes as presented. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote

Jim Everhart motioned to reaffirm the Park Board officers in their current positions. Chris Chretien seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

The Board reviewed the flood plains at Community and Flory Park so they can better address development requests.

Recreation:

Little league and the midget programs have submitted requests for field use. Chris Chretien will make sure that liability insurance is up to date.

Grounds:

Nothing to report at this time. We are on the last year of the mowing contract.

Buildings & Trails:

New rules and regulation signs are planned. The wood on pavilions will be sealed as it has been about five (5) years since they were last treated.

Old Business:

The lighting project at Flory Park is completed and the Board was pleased with the results.

There has been no movement with Eastwood Homeowners regarding land.

Resident vs. Non-Resident Pavilion Rentals – Statistics show that more non-residents rent the pavilions than East Lampeter Township residents in the past two (2) years. John Lamparter made a motion to increase pavilion rental rates for non-residents to \$100.00 and the rate for Township residents will remain at \$60.00. Chris Chretien amended the amount to \$85.00 for non-residents. Jim Everhart seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Mr. Matt Kofroth from the Lancaster County Conservation District will update the Board about the Mill Creek project at an upcoming meeting.
