

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, February 23, 2011 at the Township Office, 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Present: Diane Tyson, Charlie Thomas, Conrad Kasperson, Jay Witmer, John Thomas and Ralph Hutchison. The meeting began at 7:00 P.M.

Recreation:

Jim Gustafson is continuing to schedule the ball fields for CV Little League. Conrad Kasperson will touch base with him. The CV Little League has secured a permit to build dugouts at Flory East. We will probably lose the field behind Lafayette Fire Company.

Grounds:

The "Meadow" project at East Lampeter Park is proceeding. Seeding will probably be in late March. The Disney Store has volunteers to help clean up the park.

Buildings and Trails:

The board reviewed lighting for Flory Park and discussed what should be in the bid package and priority areas. The board recommended that the East side of the park has priority. The board also recommended the Township contact PP&L about adding lights to existing poles on Strasburg Pike.

The board also discussed adding buffers to the stream areas. The Conservation District has low cost saplings available. It was also suggested that Senator Brubaker's Office be contacted about Chesapeake Bay Clean Up resources.

Old Business:

Several plaques have been requested for Flory Park Memorial Lane.

Conrad Kasperson asked about agendas for future meetings. The board was requested to submit agenda items to the office a few days prior to the meeting.

Charlie Thomas reviewed the status of the mowing contract bids.
