

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

June 27, 2012

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, June 27, 2012 at the Township Office, 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Conrad Kasperson, Jim Everhart, John Lamparter, and Chris Chretien. Also present was Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager and Charlie Thomas, Public Works Director. Diane Tyson was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Kasperson at 7:00 pm.

The May 23, 2012 minutes were approved as presented.

Public Comment:

No public was present for comments.

Reports:

There was no recreation reports offered.

Buildings, Trails & Ground:

Timberland and Target will have volunteers to work in the Township parks.

The grass cutting is looking better.

Will spray for weeds at a later date. Spraying now is not suggested.

The GPAB (Greenway Parks Advisory Board) meeting was hosted at East Lampeter Township and went well.

There has been no vandalism in the parks for the last 1½ months.

Lighting:

The lighting at Flory Park is moving forward. There will be a delay in getting materials once the order is placed for materials. We have proposals that need verified before proceeding.

Old Business:

The updates to the Park Ordinance were reviewed. Requiring a security deposit, in addition to the rental fee, was discussed. It was decided to not add a security deposit.

Section 10 change – Change Memorial Lane trees to just memorials. This would cover any item donated as a memorial.

Section 3A – A clarification of the term of having a pet on a leash will be clarified.

Eastwood Meadows:

Township officials met with representatives of Eastwood Meadows and Eastland Estates concerning the transfer of land or rights for property usage for a park. The matter is being researched.

Horseshoe Pits:

We are still waiting for answers from our insurance carrier concerning the installation of horseshoe pits.

Other Business:

Smoking in the parks was discussed. Placing signs in the parks that would be contributed in support of Part 3 of Section M of the Park Ordinance will be researched.

Meeting adjourned at 8:20 pm. Next meeting scheduled for July 25, 2012.
