

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP  
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, September 25, 2013 at the Township Office, 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. A motion was made by John Lamparter and seconded by Chris Chretien to approve the August 28, 2013 minutes as presented. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.

**Recreation:**

**Building, Grounds and Trails:**

Tree planting is ready for Saturday, September 28. The newspaper did have an article and the public works department will start drilling holes.

Penn State looked at Community Park to improve the buffer there. They will donate 80 trees and there is a church group who will volunteer to plant them in early October.

Pavilions have been pressured washed and treated and should be OK for about 5 years.

**Old Business:**

Signs have been posted to include new park regulations/fines. The fines are on a different color paper so it stands out.

No movement on the Old Philadelphia Pike/Mill Creek property or on the homeowners group that has land bordering Flory Park.

Charlie Thomas gave pavilion rental information from the past 2 years (resident vs. non-resident). More residents have rented pavilions this year versus last year.

Budget for next year will include renovation of the lower bathrooms at Community Park.
