

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP  
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD  
October 26, 2016**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, October 26, 2016 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Jim Everhart, Chris Chretien, Diane Tyson, Blayde Eberly and John Lamparter. Also present were Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager and Charlie Thomas, Public Works Director. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

**Approval of Minutes:**

John Lamparter made a motion to approve the September 28, 2016 minutes as presented. Chris Chretien seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

**Recreation:**

There was no fall ball scheduled this year as not enough youth signed up.

**Grounds, Buildings & Trails:**

We only have one tractor trailer of mulch but bought additional mulch from East Hempfield who had some left over from a park project. Some trees were taken down at Flory Park along with the split rail fence that was rotting. There are still some issues with the controllers on the lights at Flory Park. The mowing season is wrapping up. There will be a November 4<sup>th</sup> meeting with the Conservation District to pre-plan what the needs are for Gibbons Park from their perspective. The restrooms will be shut down around November 14<sup>th</sup>.

**Old Business:**

Jim Everhart discussed the kick-off for the inter-municipal park planning for bike paths.

**New Business:**

Charlie Thomas suggested that park regulations might want to consider restricting confetti and water balloons as they are difficult for the public works department to clean-up. The Board discussed the problems with enforcement, security deposit options and

paperwork. Diane Tyson made a motion to include but not limited to these as examples under the existing park regulations. The motion was seconded by John Lamparter.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Lamparter and seconded by Mr. Chretien. The next meeting is scheduled for January 25, 2017 at 7:00 pm.
