

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD
February 22, 2017**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, February 22, 2017 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Chris Chretien, Diane Tyson, Jim Everhart and John Lamparter. Absent was Blayde Eberly. Also present were Ralph Hutchison, Township Manager and Charlie Thomas, Public Works Director. The meeting was called to order at 7 pm by Jim Everhart.

Public:

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Lamparter made a motion to approve the January 25, 2017 minutes as presented. Mr. Chretien seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Public Comment:

Wendell Miller of CV Little League is requesting permission to build a fence on field #1. He stated that the fence would be a permanent chain link fence similar to the other but just a little longer in length. He stated that the league would pay all the costs. Both fields at Flory Park were rehabbed and groomed this year. Ms. Tyson made a motion to recommend approval of the erection of the fence at Flory Park. Mr. Chretien seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Recreation:

The documents for CV Softball to use Community Park for practices is in progress. We are waiting for insurance. Mr. Chretien made a motion to permit CV Youth Athletic Association to use the fields. Ms. Tyson seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote. There will need to be communication if the pavilion is rented during the week so there is no conflict. There is no schedule or insurance yet from the Midget organization for Tower Park.

Grounds, Buildings & Trails:

New signs for exercise equipment. Mulch is being laid. Bathrooms will get nonslip epoxy coating on the floors. The old playground equipment that no longer meets safety standards has been salvaged. It may have value to a collector.

Old Business:

RFP for the Open Space study will go out in April. The Steering Committee will meet soon. The Heritage Trail kickoff meeting is March 2, 2017 at the Farm & Home Center. Ms. Tyson and Mr. Everhart are planning to attend.

New Business:
