

**EAST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP  
PARKS AND RECREATION  
BOARD  
June 27, 2018**

The East Lampeter Township Parks and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, June 27, 2018 at the Township Office: 2250 Old Philadelphia Pike, Lancaster, PA 17602. Board members present were: Chris Chretien, Jim Everhart, Joel Bare, Diane Tyson and Charles Thomas. The meeting was called to order by Jim Everhart at 7 pm.

**Public:**

**Approval of Minutes:**

A motion was made by Mr. Bare to approve the minutes of the May 23, 2018 meeting Mr. Chretien seconded the motion and it was passed by unanimous voice vote.

**Recreation:**

Not much is going on. Baseball season is done.

**Grounds, Buildings & Trails:**

- No word yet on Gibbons Park grant. The township is also looking to write an MS4 grant that will effect Community Park.
- The June 9<sup>th</sup> clean up went on as scheduled. About a ton of trash was collected!
- The Eagle Scout project at Flory Park West is complete. A dedication ceremony will be held shortly.
- Eight trees were recently removed at Community Park due to leaf scorch.

**Old Business:**

Park Survey has only 90 or so responses so far. Diane expressed concern that plans will be developed with so little input. She suggested "election type" signs in the Parks asking people to "TAKE OUR PARK SURVEY" with a web address or QR code. Jim Everhart suggested news articles in either the Penny Saver or LNP. He offered to write it if needed. A fall event to review the plans are in the works.

**New Business:**

In June 2016 the board discussed large groups (over 300) who conveyed on the park at the same time. Both of the pavilions were rented to groups of 60 & 90. There is not enough parking to accommodate this many people. The board needs to set a per person limit per pavilion (that would not be advertised to prevent renters “fudging “the figures). The New guidelines would go into effect for next year.

A motion to adjourn the meeting 7:25 was made by Mr. Chretien and seconded by Mr. Bare and unanimously approved. The next meeting is scheduled for July 25, 2018 at 7:00 pm.
