

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 10**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LAMPETER,  
LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, MAKING A  
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENDITURES  
WITHIN THE POLICE FORFEITURE FUND (04) FOR THE  
2019 FISCAL YEAR**

Back ground:

The Board of Supervisors has, on or about December 17, 2018, adopted the 2019 Budgets for all Township funds including the Police Forfeiture Fund (04). As part of a 2019 review of the Township's armory by the Police Department's new Range Master, it was concluded a larger, more secure and more organized method for storing weapons was needed. After careful research, the Chief of Police chose an item which would satisfy the identified needs. The purchase of this item was not part of the original 2019 Budget because of the timing of the review. Therefore, the Chief is hereby requesting the purchase of the item at this time as a supplemental appropriation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors for the Township of East Lampeter, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby makes supplemental appropriation from the Police Forfeiture Fund (04) for the following expenditure :

Metal Gun/Rifle Storage Locker - \$2,500.00 Account# 04.410.260


Total of the above appropriation is \$2,500.00


2. This resolution and the requirements contained in it shall be effective immediately.


